

## **Welcome to Housing at SUNY Adirondack!**

What is provided in a SUNY Adirondack Residence Hall Suite?

- There is a couch, armchair, dining table, two dining chairs, entertainment stand, end table, cable, and internet.
- Kitchen area has cabinets and a sink.
- In Each bedroom, for each student, there is a standard twin bed, standard twin mattress, armoire, desk, and desk chair.
- There is a double vanity sink, toilet, shower, and toilet paper holder in each bathroom.

### **Required Items to Bring**

- Cleaning supplies for your room, common room, and bathroom. Cleaning staff do not clean student spaces while they are occupied.
- Vinyl shower curtain (36" wide x72" tall)
- Toilet paper

### **Items to Consider Bringing**

#### **Bedroom:**

- Bed pillows/protector
- Comforter and/or blanket
- Mattress topper/pad
- Standard Twin sheet sets (NOT XL)

#### **Bathroom:**

- Hair Dryer
- Robe
- Shower tote/caddy
- Slippers/flip flops
- Toothbrush
- Toilet paper
- Towels/washcloths

#### **Cleaning Supplies:**

- All-purpose cleaner
- Broom and dust pan/vacuum
- Garbage bags
- Garbage cans for bedroom and bathroom
- Kitchen/bathroom cleaning supplies
- Mop
- Paper towels
- Soap
- Sponges

#### **Kitchen:**

- Coffeemakers (with automatic shut-off)
- Cups and mugs
- Eating utensils
- Microwave (one per suite)
- Mini Fridge not to exceed 3 cubic feet (one per bedroom and common area)
- Plates and bowls
- Toaster or toaster oven

#### **Laundry:**

- 
- Fabric Softener
  - Laundry detergent
  - Laundry basket/hamper

**Miscellaneous items to consider:**

- Area rug
- First Aid Kit
- Flashlight
- Floor lamp
- Hangers
- Keyring or lanyard for bedroom keys
- Shoe storage
- Student ID holder
- Umbrella
- Under-bed storage
- Warm and cold weather clothing

**The following items are NOT permitted in the Residence Hall\*:**

- Air conditioners
- Alcohol paraphernalia (for example: beer taps, funnels, kegs, empty or full alcohol containers, etc.)
- Animals (including fish) with the exception of approved emotional support animals and service animals
- Candles/incense
- Cooking devices including; electric griddles, hot pots, George Foreman grills, roasting pans, etc.
- Culinary Arts knives (must store them at the Culinary building)
- Dart boards with sharp point darts
- Drug-related paraphernalia, illegal drugs, non-prescribed narcotics, and/or drug-related devices
- E-Cigarettes and charging devices for e-cigarettes
- Halogen light bulbs
- Hoverboards should not be used or stored
- Lava lamps
- LED light strips
- Live Christmas/holiday trees
- Multi-arm floor lamps
- Multi-plug outlets or extension cords unless they are UL approved and have a surge protector
- Nails and foam-backed adhesive tape
- Possession and/or use of weapons or firearms of any kind
- Safes
- Space heaters
- Tapestries or any items hung from the ceiling
- Wall units to mount a television
