

Articulation Agreement

SUNY Adirondack, Liberal Arts and Sciences, Humanities & Social Sciences, A.A.

Art Studio Track

and

Russell Sage College, Creative Arts in Therapy, B.A.

Objective

This articulation agreement is intended to facilitate the transfer of qualified students currently enrolled in the Liberal Arts and Sciences, Humanities & Social Sciences, A.A. Art Studio Track program at SUNY Adirondack into the B.A. Creative Arts in Therapy program at Russell Sage College. Counselors at SUNY Adirondack can use the information in this agreement to advise current students as they express an interest in the Creative Arts in Therapy program as to which SUNY Adirondack courses should be taken prior to application for transfer.

Terms of Agreement

This articulation agreement, once signed will be effective immediately and must be reviewed and re-approved in the same manner at least once every two years hereafter, in order to remain in effect.

The procedures of review and re-approval shall be as follows:

- The latest available catalogs of the two institutions are reviewed by the RSC Creative Arts in Therapy Program Coordinator and the revised draft is prepared by the Creative Arts in Therapy Program Coordinator.
- A final draft is signed by the department chairs of both institutions and by the appropriate administrator of both institutions.
- All of the most recently published rules for accepting transfer students into programs of RSC apply. The agreement supplements, but does not supersede or replace what was written in the latest RSC catalog.

RSC agrees to accept and transfer into the B.A. program up to 66 credit hours earned by the student at SUNY Adirondack who takes the courses listed below. Only courses of earned grades of C- or better will transfer, and the students who attain a combined Grade Point Average (GPA) of a 2.5 in courses will automatically be admitted into the SCA program.

This agreement covers courses taken at SUNY Adirondack only. If students from SUNY Adirondack have credits on their transcripts from other institutions, the published RSC rules for accepting transferred credit will apply to those credits.

If students from SUNY Adirondack wish to transfer without having completed all of the courses in this agreement, they are assured that the identified equivalent courses with C- or better will transfer, but outright admission into the program will not be guaranteed. All transfer students must meet with a Creative Arts and Therapy Advisor to plan their courses and to determine how many semesters are required for degree completion. Degree completion may vary by student, according to the number of credits transferred and course scheduling. *A portfolio review is also a requirement for admission.*
