



## **Nursing – Articulation Agreement**

### **Maria College and Adirondack Community College**

The purposes of this agreement are as follows:

1. To facilitate the effective transition of transfer of qualified students holding the Associates in Science degree in Nursing from Adirondack Community College to Maria College.
2. To foster continuous communication between the respective departments to provide accurate and timely advisement for interested students.

Terms of the agreement:

Maria College agrees to accept qualified students who have earned an Associates in Science degree in Nursing from Adirondack Community College who have their RN license to Maria College with full junior standing when transferring to the RN-BS program at Maria College.

Maria College agrees to accept 60 academic credits toward the Baccalaureate degree from Adirondack Community College. An individual transfer credit evaluation will be provided by the Maria College Admissions Office to determine whether the Adirondack Community College graduate has met the 30-credit hour Liberal Arts requirement associate degree and holds a current registered nurse license.

Maria College agrees to accept and transfer 60 credit hours to fulfill the first two years (freshman and sophomore) of college. However, in accordance with general college policy, additional transfer credit will be allowed up to 12 credit hours if these credits can be identified as equivalent to the required courses in the RN-BS Program.

Maria College will accept graduates from Adirondack Community College who meet the following admissions requirements:

3 Credits of English Composition  
3 Credits of Developmental/Life Span Psychology  
8 Credits Anatomy and Physiology  
4 Credits Microbiology  
12 Credits Liberal Arts Electives

- Current RN license with the United States or U.S. territory and professional liability coverage or have met the RN licensure requirement within 6 months of the completion of the two-year associates degree in nursing.
- Ability to meet both college and clinical agency health requirements.
- Two favorable references which address professional and/or academic ability (e.g., nursing faculty member, nursing supervisor)

- A cumulative grade point average (GPA) of at least 2.5.
- Typewritten autobiographical statement which includes educational and career goals.
- Completion of an interview with nursing faculty representative.
- Have appropriate health clearance requirements on file in the Nursing Program office prior to clinical facilities visits.
