


Objective:


To facilitate the transfer of students from the Nursing program at Adirondack Community College into the Nursing program at The Sage Colleges

Terms of Agreement:

1. The published standards of admission to The Sage Colleges will apply.
2. The Sage Colleges will accept into the baccalaureate program all graduates who have completed the Associate Degree in Nursing with a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.00 (4.00) system and the recommendation of their Nursing Chairperson at Adirondack Community College.
3. Transfer credits will be earned at The Sage Colleges for grades of ``C`` or above for up to 60 credit hours earned by the student at Adirondack Community College. Advanced standing will be given for thirty (30) nursing credits completed in the associate degree program at Adirondack Community College.
4. Adirondack Community College Nursing majors who are interested in pursuing a baccalaureate degree after completion of the associate degree may contact the Department of Nursing at any time for early advisement and program planning.
5. Requirements for the degree at The Sage Colleges may be completed either on a full-time or part-time basis.
6. A minimum of 120 credit hours is required for the baccalaureate degree. At least 30 credit hours must be completed within The Sage Colleges.
7. This agreement is effective as of the 2013-2014 academic year. It will be reviewed at the end of five years, and will be renegotiated at the request of either institution or if there is a substantial change in the relevant curricula of either institution.
