

SUBMITTING A CERTIFICATE OF RESIDENCE Saratoga County

New York residents receive a considerable discount on in-state tuition at New York public colleges and universities. Students enrolled in SUNY Adirondack CHS are eligible to receive this discount provided they have submitted a Certificate of Residence (COR).

Step 1

Please visit the <u>Saratoga County COR website</u> for details about submitting the Saratoga County Certificate of Residence application (in person or online). Certificates of Residence start being issued 60 days before the start of each college semester.

NOTE: After classes start, you must go to the Saratoga County office at 40 McMaster St., Ballston Spa.

Step 2

Once your student has been issued a Certificate of Residence, scan and email it to <u>studentaccounts@sunyacc.edu</u>.

Fall 2025 CORs are due by October 8. Spring 2026 CORs are due by March 3.

Not submitting a COR on time will influence your student's tuition rate. Instead of \$80 per credit hour, you will be charged \$120.

Most Certificates of Residence are **valid for one year based on semester (not by date)**. Students who submit a COR for a class they're taking in the fall do not have to submit a new one for the spring.

IMPORTANT! Wait to obtain a COR if your student is taking a yearlong CHS course. You will need one for Spring '26; they start being issued 60 days before the start of the spring semester.
