**IMPORTANT!** Wait to obtain a COR if your student is taking a yearlong CHS course. You will need one for Spring '25; they start being issued 60 days before the start of the spring semester.



**New York residents receive a considerable discount on in-state tuition at New York public colleges and universities.** If your student is registered or plans to register for a SUNY Adirondack CHS course, they are eligible to receive this discount!

**Residents of Warren and Washington counties:** complete the [SUNY Adirondack Residency form](#) and have it notarized.

Residents of other counties: [Download a form](#) or request one from your county office.

Certificates of Residence start being issued 60 days before the start of each college semester.

Scan and email the SUNY Adirondack Residency form (or a Certificate of Residence issued from another county) to [studentaccounts@sunyacc.edu](mailto:studentaccounts@sunyacc.edu).

**Fall 2024** CORs are due by **Sept. 25.**  
**Spring 2025** CORs are due by **Feb. 18.**

**Not submitting a COR on time will influence your student's tuition rate. Instead of \$77 per credit hour, you will be charged \$116.**

---

Most Certificates of Residence are **valid for one year based on semester (not by date)**. Students who submit a COR for a class they're taking in the fall do not have to submit a new one for the spring.
